Safety & Security for HEP TX

<u>Parking Lot Safety & Logistics</u> – Please watch out for students walking between vehicles. During busy times we try to help watch, but it is not possible to always have eyes in all places and at all times. Also, when you are backing out of parking places use extra caution. Please leave room for a vehicle to pass you in the driving zone. Our parking lot has a lot of little ones crossing and we do not want to have an accident.



RESERVED PARKING

We have a marked handicapped parking spot (to the right of the sidewalk), so please DO NOT park in this place unless you are handicapped. We have a sign, but it is not directly in front of the handicapped space.

We hope to mark the parking in front of the sidewalk with yellow stripes. This will allow a wider area for people to walk to the sidewalk instead of walking between the cars. So, until marked, please do not park in front of the sidewalk or in the handicapped parking place unless handicapped.

IMPORTANT SECURITY UPDATE!!!!

Security Card Checkup – Last summer, many parents expressed concerns about building safety. We listened to you and implemented an expensive security system at the front entrance to the school. Coupled with our security cameras, employee training, and the security identification system, we have met your concerns about school security. **Now, we need your help as many students are not taking the SECURITY CARDS seriously.** These cards are a key to the building. If lost, they leave the school vulnerable. Therefore, we ask that all parents talk with their students and reiterate the serious breach of security that is created when a card is lost or stolen.

Please check with your students who received a security card to make sure they still have them. Since these cards allow access to our building, all lost cards need to be deactivated immediately and the student issued a new card. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for replacements. Some students are not bringing their cards and are ringing the doorbell.





This next week we will have a security card check to see if students still have possession of their cards. All students should wear the security card on a lanyard (available from Mrs. Henry) around their necks so that we can quickly see them. As students enter the building, we will note if they have their cards. If they do not have their cards, we will mark the card as lost and the card will be deactivated for safety reasons. If the student forgot his card, he will be allowed to bring the card to the office when he comes on campus again. We

will then reactivate it. If students do NOT have their cards, and do not bring them to the office for the security check, the family will be billed \$25.00 for a replacement. Please understand we implemented this system for safety reasons. We need to make sure everyone's cards are accounted for. We will deactivate lost ones and issue new ones.

Parents and other visitors need to ring the doorbell for entry without a keycard. We ask all parents/visitors to check in at the front counter BEFORE GOING TO CLASSROOMS.

WORK INTERRUPTION: Please use the security cards as they save our office workers from being constantly interrupted while working. Can you imagine our staff having to answer the doorbell 40-50 times a day? This is how many students are NOT using their security cards.

We are serious about safety at HEP TX!

Handy Reminders:



- Students should not arrive prior to 8:40 a.m. for a 9 a.m. class. The SECURITY cards do not work until 8:40 am.
- Please do not ring the doorbell. Bring your security card.
 This is another layer of security as the card shows you are present on campus.
- There is no microwave available for heating lunches.
- Students should remember to bring their own napkins and eating utensils.
- The Great Room is for all to enjoy. Please remind your students to clean up after themselves. There are cleaning wipes provided to wipe down their tables, and food, etc. should not be left after they have returned to class.
- Students should print papers at home. This service is no longer available.
- Jr. High and High School students should use their security cards to enter the building even when leaving for lunch, etc. This helps us monitor students on campus.



Please remember that HEP and our families are partners in education.

In order for students to be successful in their classes, parents must work with their students at home. Check the weekly assignment sheet and help your student plan a study/homework schedule. Check the student's work. Proof-read papers. Make sure the student has the backpack ready the night before class.

Parents, you are the keys to making sure the students are successful! Don't let your student homeschool himself. This does NOT work.

Chess Club Meets on the 2nd Tuesday of Each Month


